Advanced Carpentry Skills Stackable VET 2024





Pathway

Successful completion of this course will provide students with further opportunities to develop the practical skills and knowledge in the area of Carpentry that will support future studies and employment opportunities in the building and construction industry.

Eligibility Prerequisites

Students will need to have successfully completed a full Certificate I or Certificate II qualification in building and construction and completed at least 1 week of work placement in the industry which may include work placement with an employer, working on a live site (eg Housing SA) etc.

A copy of the qualification Certificate and Workplace Learning Agreement must be provided.

Occupational outcomes

This course offers participants the opportunity to gain trade related competencies that could lead to an Apprenticeship in the Construction industry as a Carpenter, Carpenter and Joiner or similar vocation.

The construction industry strongly affirms that training and assessment leading to recognition of skills musty be undertaken in a real or very closely simulated workplace environment, this qualification requires all units of competency to be delivered in this context. A period of work placement is strongly recommended to ensure training outcomes are met.

Special requirements

In order to successfully complete the course, students must make a commitment to attend ALL training and complete all work required, both practical and theory.

Students must adhere to all safety requirements as directed by their trainer. The approved GJTTC uniform and PPE will be required during all training

Students will be provided with the following necessary Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and uniform which must be worn:

- · High visibility jumper
- · High visibility work shirt
- Safety glasses
- Work gloves and glove clip
- Ear protection

Additional Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to be purchased by the student prior to commencement:
